Mile 10/16ish- Aid Station & Porta Potty/Ione Church  
Mile 11- Aid Station/ C Bar C Road  
Mile 13ish- Aid Station & Porta Potty/ Crazy Duck Crossing **Full Marathon Turnaround**

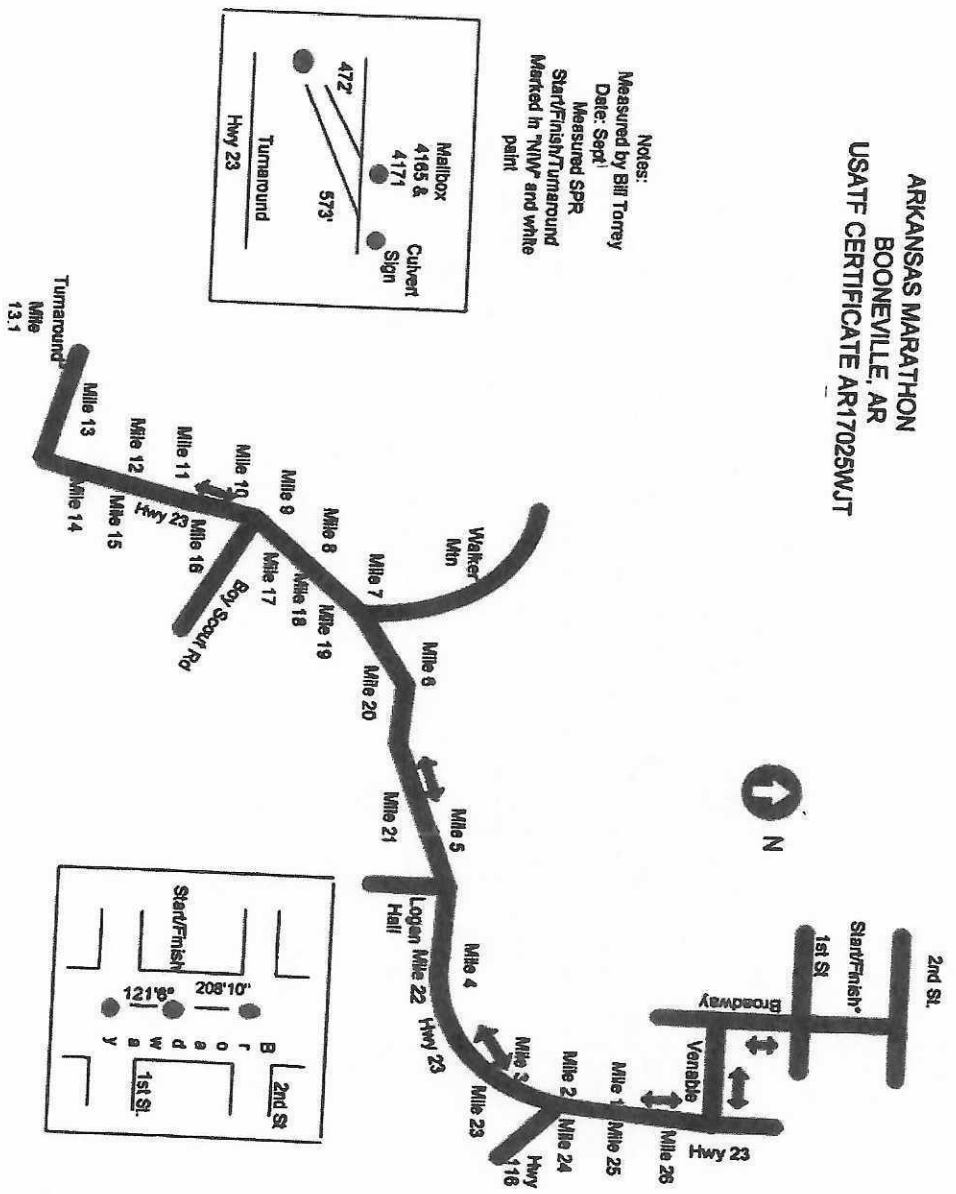
